MCKENZIE VILLERS SCHOLARSHIP

(This is administered by Canterbury Education Services and is usually due in by the beginning of November each year – please contact them directly)

Eligibility

The candidate must produce a certificate from the Principal of his school certifying:

- * that the candidate can swim a distance of 100 yards (approx 100 metres).
- * that he has taken an active part in leadership in activities of the school.

In addition, the Principal should provide a letter of recommendation.

The scholarship shall be awarded primarily on the basis of the examination results, but the

recommendations of the principal of the candidate's school and such other information as may seem appropriate, may also be taken into account.

Purpose

The scholarship is open to boys attending a registered public primary or intermediate school in the former Canterbury Education District who have not attained the age of 14 years on the first day of December in the year of selection and who are born of New Zealand citizens.
